Criteria for CAEE projects:

- New and innovative policy and or planning tool,
- Reduces GHG emissions and / or increases energy efficiency or air quality,
- Applicability to other communities,
- Quality of proposal

# Examples of successful CAEE projects

- Squamish's Catalyst Sustainability Block, Bowen Island's Green Building Policy, Ucluelet's OCP review and tidal energy, Whistler's offset calculator and others
