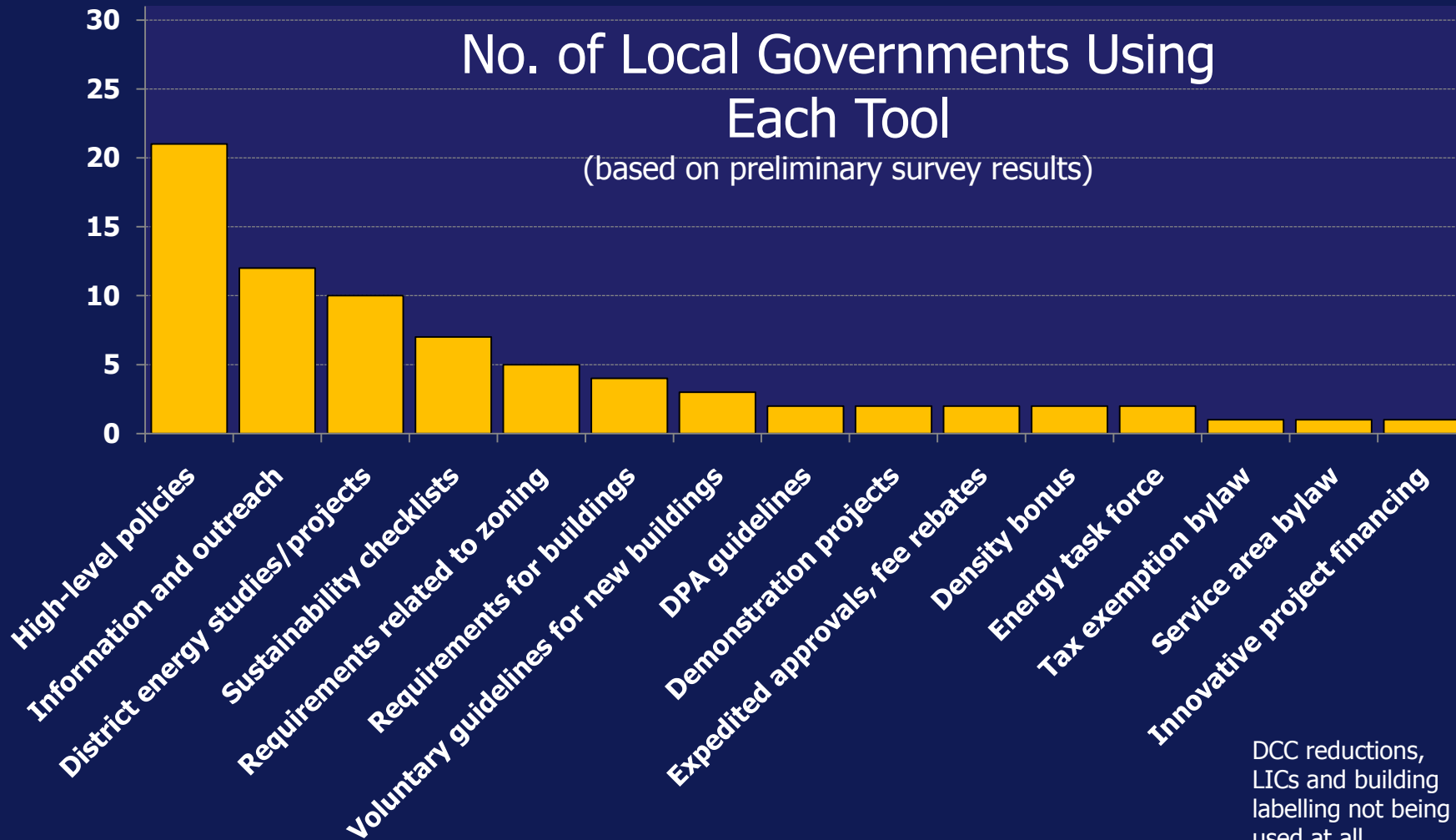

(based on preliminary survey results)

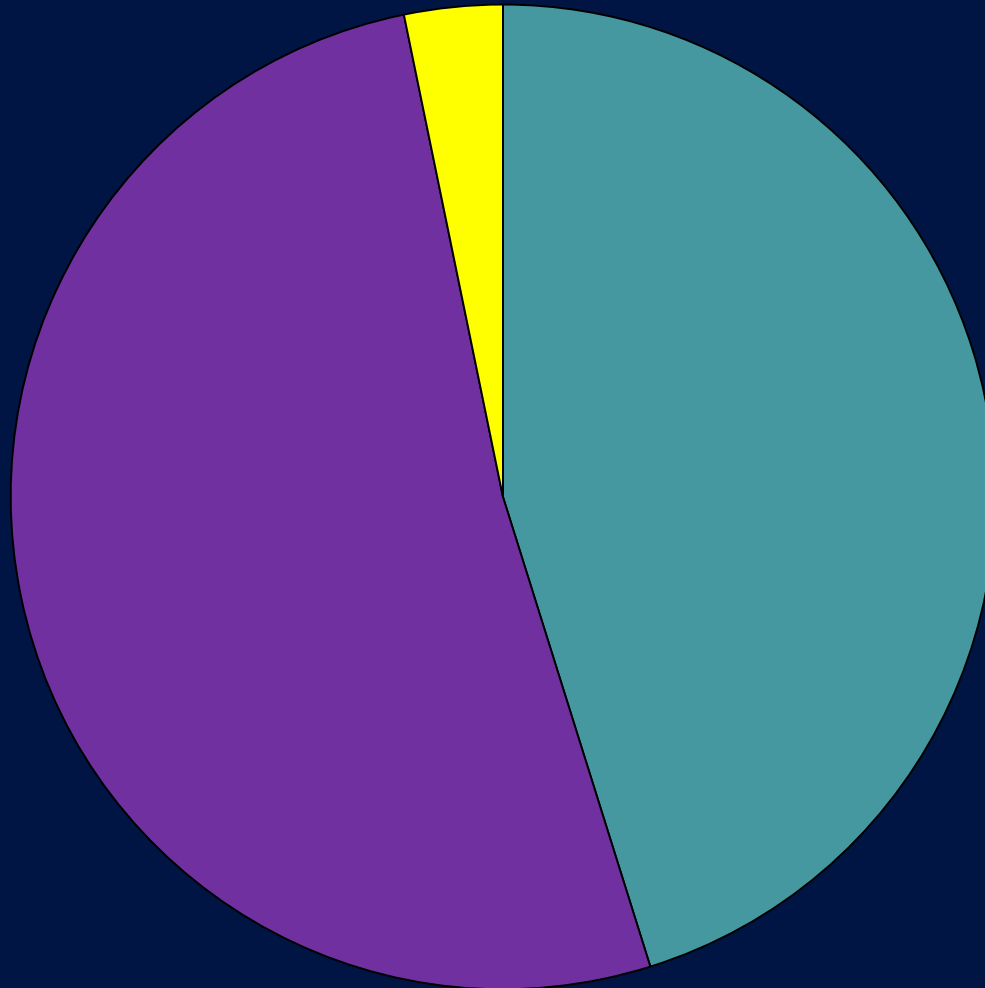


DCC reductions,

(based on preliminary survey results)

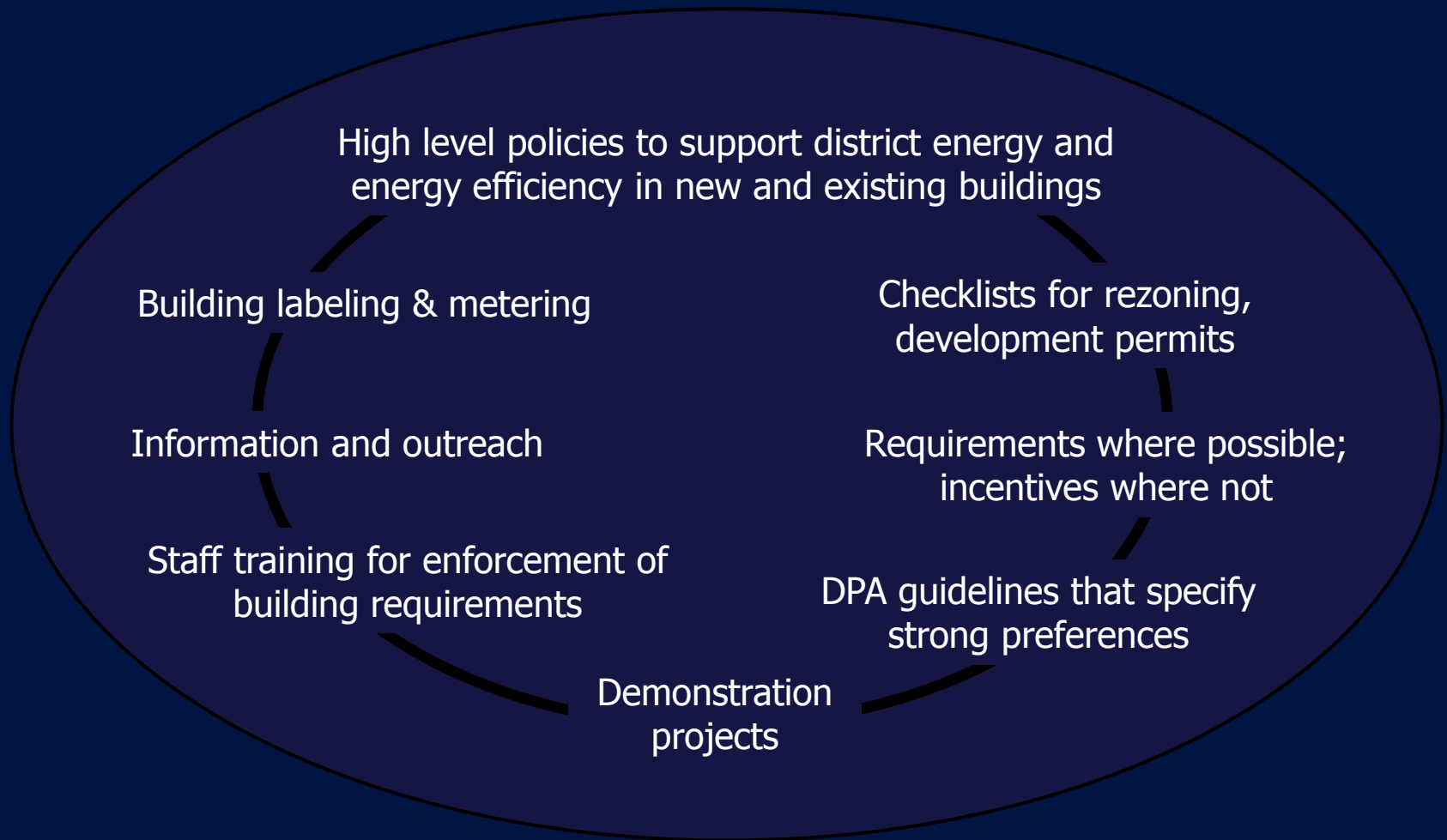


■ No. LGs Using 0 - 2 Tools

■ No. LGs Using 5 - 10 Tools

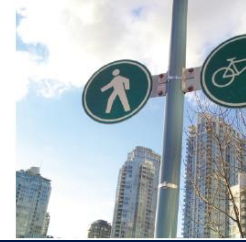
A full suite of initiatives might look like:
